HOW WE COLLECT DATA

COOKIES

Cookies are information stored on the hard drive of your PC and which are sent by your browser to a Web server, and which relate to your use of the network.

This information is not, therefore, provided spontaneously and directly, and leaves a trace. The data collected through cookies will be used for technical needs, in order to ensure easier, more immediate and faster access to the site and its services and easier navigation to the individual user.
